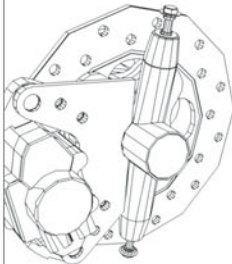

### Undergraduate Admissions

You can apply online or by completing a paper application. There is an application fee of \$35 for both the online and paper applications. We recommend that you apply early in the fall of your senior year.

- **Undergraduate Application Deadlines**  
Fall semester deadline: April 1  
Spring semester deadline: November 1

### Graduate Admissions

You can apply online or by completing a paper application. There is an application fee of \$50 for both the online and paper applications.

- **Graduate Application Deadlines**  
Fall semester deadline: July 1  
Spring semester deadline: November 1
- **International Graduate Application Deadlines**  
Fall semester deadline: December 15  
Spring semester deadline: August 1
